Strawberry Valentines Chex Mix

Ingredients ~

4-6 cups Rice Chex cereal

1 8- oz bag Strawberry Candy Melts **OR** 1 bag of white chocolate baking chips {12 oz}

1 box of Strawberry Creme Jell-O **Pudding**** {pudding *NOT* gelatin!}

Valentines M&M's and/or Sprinkles

Instructions ~

Measure out Chex cereal into a large bowl. **Note:** if you're using the Strawberry Candy Melts, you'll use 4 cups of cereal. If you're using the white chocolate chips + pudding mix, you'll use 6 cups of cereal.

Pour chocolate into a small glass dish. Add 1/2 tsp shortening, if desired, to help the chocolate coat the cereal easier. Microwave for 1 minute 20 seconds. Let sit in the microwave for 3 minutes. Remove and gently stir. If chocolate loses its shape and looks smooth, it's done. If not, return to the microwave in 15 second increments, letting it sit for 2-3 minutes each time, until melted and smooth.

If you used White Chocolate Chips + Pudding Mix: Add 4 TBSP of the strawberry creme pudding into the white chocolate and stir gently until smooth. Add 2 drops of red food coloring, if desired.

Pour the chocolate mixture over the Chex cereal and stir gently to coat.

Transfer cereal mixture to a large piece of wax paper. Sprinkle with M&M's and Valentines sprinkles, if desired. Let cool to set. Break pieces and store in an airtight container to save. Candy can be made up to 3-4 days ahead, if desired. It saves well!

Facts About Presidents Day

Presidents Day is a federal holiday observed on the third Monday of February in the United States.

Presidents Day was created to commemorate George Washington. Following the Revolution, Washington became the first President of the United States and is largely considered as the country's father.

This means that many government personnel will be off on Presidents Day, and most government offices will be closed.

Most schools and educational institutions across the country mark the holiday as well. This implies that on Presidents Day, students often take the day off and schools are closed.

Five Presidents were born in February.

In addition to George Washington and Abraham Lincoln, three more United States Presidents were born in February. They are as follows:

William Henry Harrison – born on February 9, 1773, was the ninth President of the United States and served the shortest tenure in American history, lasting only 31 days before succumbing to illness.

Ronald Reagan – born on February 6, 1911, was the 40th President of the United States, serving two terms from 1981 to 1989. Reagan is largely considered to be one of the most powerful presidents in contemporary American history.

Chester A. Arthur – born on October 5, 1829, was the 21st President of the United States, serving from 1881 to 1885. He took over the presidency when President James A. Garfield was assassinated and is noted for his efforts to modernize the civil service and his strong position on civil rights.

Along with Washington and Lincoln, these Presidents all played important roles in shaping the United States and are honored for their contributions to the country. Americans can celebrate and honor the legacies of these five Presidents and their contributions to American history by celebrating Presidents Day in February.

The United States Senate usually honors Presidents Day by reciting George Washington's Farewell Address. Washington wrote the Farewell Address in 1796, as he was about to leave office after two terms as President.

In the letter, Washington reflects on his time in office, offers guidance for the country's future, and expresses his hopes for the American people's future.

The reading of Washington's Farewell Address on Presidents Day is a long-standing tradition that serves as a reminder of Washington's wisdom and guidance to the country during a period of significant transition and uncertainty.

REMINDER — “Uflex”- Rent Payment Option —

Fremont Housing Agency offers the option to pay your rent online through your checking or savings account. This feature allows you to pay rent from the comfort and safety of your own home. **You can go to www.myuflex.com to register and sign up to pay your rent on-line.**

Once you have signed up, you will be able to use your checking or savings account to pay your monthly rent. Allow 2 to 3 weeks for Uflex to process your registration to ensure you are able to utilize the system for online payments.

When you make a payment, you will receive confirmation of your payment and your account will be immediately credited indicating you have successfully paid rent for the month. Currently there is a fee of \$1 per transaction to use this feature.

We are giving you a very convenient way to pay your rent if you choose to use it, but we will always accept checks or money orders for payments. This is just another option we are offering to our Residents.
