### Ham And Noodle Casserole

#### Ingredients

- ♦ 8 oz. uncooked egg noodles
- ♦ 1 (10 1/2-oz.) can cream of mushroom soup, undiluted
- ♦ 1 (8-oz.) container chive-and-onion-flavored cream cheese, softened
- ♦ 2/3 cup milk
- ♦ 2 cups chopped baked ham
- ♦ 1 1/2 cups fresh broccoli florets
- ♦ 1 (10-oz.) package frozen asparagus, thawed (or frozen peas)
- ♦ 6 baby carrots, chopped
- ♦ 1 (8-oz.) package shredded mozzarella cheese
- ♦ 1 (4-oz.) package shredded Cheddar cheese
- ♦ 1/2 cup crushed seasoned croutons

#### Directions

1. Cook pasta according to package directions; drain.
2. Stir together soup, cream cheese, and milk in a large bowl. Stir in pasta, ham, broccoli, asparagus (or peas) and carrots.
3. Spoon half of ham mixture into a lightly greased 13 x 9 inch baking dish.
4. Mix cheeses together and sprinkle half of it over ham mixture.
5. Spoon remaining ham mixture into the baking dish.
6. Combine remaining cheese mixture with croutons and sprinkle over the ham mixture to finish.
7. Bake at 400°F for 30 minutes or until lightly browned. **Cool slightly and Enjoy!**

- 1) Hold your head high. Keep your gaze to the horizon and enjoy the scenery.
- 2) Place shoulders back with eyes forward.
- 3) Move shoulders freely and naturally.
- 4) Tighten mid-section/core.
- 5) Swing your arms in a natural motion. Move the opposite leg with the opposite arm.
- 6) Tuck your pelvis under your torso.
- 7) Position your feet straight ahead, parallel to each other.
- 8) Push off with your back leg.
