Our April monthly meal is Potluck, on April 9th at 5:00. Note that we are now moving the time to our summer hours.

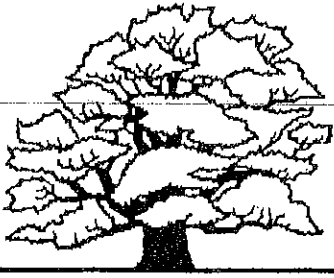
