

Veterans Day on November 11th honors military veterans who served in the United States Armed Forces. The federal holiday coincides with Armistice Day and Remembrance Day, which marks World War I. These observances reflect the end of significant hostilities at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 when the Armistice with Germany took effect. Initially, the United States observed Armistice Day as well. However, it evolved into the current Veterans Day in 1954.

U.S. President Woodrow Wilson first proclaimed Armistice Day on November 11, 1919. At the time, he said, “To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country’s service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations.”.

**CLEANING YOUR HOME**

As a tenant you are responsible for keeping your apartment in a decent, safe & sanitary condition in order to protect the property and keep yourself in the best health that you can be. Good housekeeping is key to avoiding an infestation of cockroaches. If you have discovered roaches in your apartment, you are responsible for informing the office **immediately** so that FHA can begin assisting you in taking care of the issue.

Infestations occur because **Cockroaches reproduce very quickly when they are living in an environment where they have access to food and water.** A single egg case can drastically worsen the situation, so do your part to curb the population before it gets out of control.

## Announcements

- ◆ SNAP benefits are adjusted yearly to account for inflation. This year's changes are based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) from the Bureau of Labor Statistics for June 2022. *Based on that data, SNAP benefits were increased by 12.5% for 12 months beginning October 1, 2022.*
- ◆ Laundry Rooms are scheduled to close briefly to allow for new machines to be installed. The dates of this work will be determined by FHA Management. Laundry Services are offered by two companies in Fremont, they are: LTD 402.727.6060 | Blue Sky 402.620.4267
- LTD Laundromat and Tan:** Pick up on Tuesdays at approximately 1:30 PM. Cleaned and folded laundry delivered back the next day. Charge \$1.25 per pound; \$3.00 Service Charge; \$20 minimum.
- Blue Sky Laundry:** Drop off service only-washed, folded and bagged laundry. Charge \$1.25 per pound.
- ◆ Attention Resident Smokers & Guest Smokers—Please utilize the Accessible Designated Smoking Areas assigned outside of both Towers. Posted signs identify the designated area's, located 25 feet from either building, windows and entrances, which are the **Smoke shelters** and the landscaped **circle of concrete** where the grills and picnic tables are located, between the Towers.
- ◆ Recently our office has had several residents call or stop by to inquire about the guidelines of having **overnight guests**. To clear this up, residents have the right to receive visitors and guests at their homes if they follow the policies established by the Housing Authority for this purpose. Fremont Housing Authority permits reasonable accommodations of Tenant's guest(s) or visitor(s) for a period **not to exceed 10 days each year**. Should there be a situation where Persons stay in the unit beyond an authorized period, FHA considers those parties as an unauthorized occupants and therefore they are trespassing. Keep in mind that applicants undergo screening in order to be considered for tenancy at any/all Public Housing Authorities. If persons join the household without undergoing screening, they are considered to be unauthorized occupants and therefore they are trespassing.
- ◆ Stanton Tower Community Room remains under construction; reopen date will be determined by Management. Stanton Tower Kitchen will be closed the remainder of the year.
- ◆ Remember to use the **proper channels** when you have a question or an issue to report. Please do **not stop staff** while they are working to tell them you have a problem.
