Fun Facts About Winter

- * You can see your breath when it's below 45 degrees Fahrenheit. You breathe in oxygen, and your exhale has water vapor, which allows the visual in the cold temperatures.
- * The first Winter Olympics occurred in 1924 in the French Alps.
- * Like birds, whales, bats, and caribou, monarch butterflies also migrate to warmer climates – escaping the Winter weather.
- * During the winter season, the North Pole has an average temperature of minus 40 degrees Fahrenheit.
- * Guinness World Records reports the largest snowflake (15" in diameter and 8" thick) had fallen during a storm in January 1887 at Fort Keogh.
- * Snowflakes are translucent. They do not change colors unless it's a case of Watermelon Snow. Watermelon snow is a natural phenomenon that turns • snow a pink or red hue. It is caused by a type of green algae called Chlamydomonas nivalis that thrives in cold, snowy environments.

RENT REMINDERS \$\$\$

- The rent is due on the 1st and late after the close of business the 5th day of each month.
- If the 5th falls on Saturday, rent is due in the office by close of business on Friday.
- If the 5th falls on Sunday, the rent must be in the drop box before 8:00 a.m. of the 6th.
- If the rent is *not paid on or before the 5th* day of the month, a *late payment charge* will be applied as follows: \$30.00 will be assessed for payments made on the 6th through the 20th day of the month.
- Payments made on the 21st day and after will be assessed at the rate of an additional \$20.00 charge.
- This late charge is immediately due as an addition to that month's rent and must be paid before that month's rent will be considered to be paid in full.

RentWise is a program to help renters obtain and keep rental housing and be successful renters through


FHA holds a live class twice a year, and it is announced in the newsletter. But the class is also available online any time. You are able to register and take the training at your own pace at no charge!

MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day seeks to honor and remember those who died while serving in the military. This day aims to raise awareness about the nation's freedom and the price for that freedom. Every year, U.S soldiers and their families pay that price.

Memorial Day is a day for reverence and honoring of those who gave their lives defending the Nation and its values. Congress declared it a national holiday in 1971. It is observed annually on the last Monday of May.

| Memorial Day facts:

- Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day.
- Memorial Day was officially declared a federal holiday in 1971.
- ↑ The red poppy flower became a symbol of remembrance after the publication of the famous war poem "In Flanders Fields" by Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae.
- ◆ There have been about 1.35 million US military deaths since 1775.
- The deadliest war the U.S has participated in was the Civil War, with around 620,000 deaths.
- It is customary to fly a US flag at half-staff till noon on Memorial Day.

Things to do for Memorial Day:

- Visit the grave of a fallen soldier.
- Attend a Memorial day parade. All Americans are encouraged to pause for one minute at 3:00 pm (local time). Think of the sacrifices made by U.S. soldiers to provide freedom for all.
- Visit a Veteran's Home.
- Donate to a charity that serves veterans.
- Have a picnic with family and friends.
