MIDWEST ALARM SERVICE FIRE ALARM TESTING



MEDICAID EXPANSION



The Department of Health and Human Services will begin accepting applications for Medicaid Heritage Health Adult Expansion on August 1, 2020. Benefits will begin on October 1, 2020.

Heritage Health Adult expands Medicaid to lower income Nebraskans age 19 to 64 who earn up to 138% of the poverty level. For 2020 this is an income of about \$17,000 per year for a single person.

Benefits will include physical health, behavioral health, and pharmacy coverage. Some applications may qualify for dental, vision, and over the counter medication coverage.

SNAP



The Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will be again issuing emergency supplemental allot-

ments to SNAP recipients who receive benefits for the month of July on August 7. DHHS filed a request with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutritional Service (FNS) to provide emergency allotment funds for Nebraska households that are receiving SNAP benefits. This is only for the people that have already been receiving SNAP benefits!

Also many questions about another stimulus check and as of now that is not a sure thing.



Remember to budget your money as you have in the past

and not count on another stimulus check.

MEAL PROGRAM


We will begin providing puzzles for you to work on while waiting for your lunch in the dining room.




