#### Zucchini Patties

1 cup Bisquick or other baking mix

½ t. salt

½ cup shredded mozzarella or cheddar cheese

2 beaten eggs

2 cups shredded zucchini

2 T. chopped onion (optional)

Combine above ingredients in mixing bowl, blend well. Spray large skillet with butter spray. Spoon heaping tablespoon of mixture into skillet. Fry 3-5 minutes preside until golden brown. Place patty on paper towel to absorb grease. Spray skillet when necessary.

#### Oven Caramel Corn

2 cups brown sugar

½ cup white corn syrup

2 sticks butter

½ t. soda

12 cups popped popcorn

Sort out unpopped corn. Combine all ingredients, but soda, and boil 5 minutes. Stir in soda, pour immediately over popped corn. Spread into large pan and place in 250\* oven for 50-60 minutes. Stir about every 15 minutes. Store in tightly sealed container.
