### SOCIAL SECURITY, MEDICARE, AND COVID VACCINE SCAM ALERTS

If you read the envelope of your Social Security award letter there is a scam alert that you should pay attention to. Many

residents have received scam calls pretending to be the government telling you that you are going to lose your social security. There are new scams telling you that you can pay to get the COVID vaccine. This is also a scam. The smartest thing to do is to not answer phone calls if you do not know the caller. If it is important they will leave a message. If it is a scam they will leave a fake number and if they say they are the Social Security office or Medicare the best thing to do is call the phone number for the Social Security office to see if they have called you. Scammers are very good at scaring people and getting their personal information. They especially like to target elderly people.

This is nothing new. It has always been this way. When you try to get downstairs to see what is going on it ties up the elevators for the EMTs and causes confusion in the lobby.
