In some parts of the country, people will shoot their own fireworks while children delight in the bright colors and sparklers.

Different Way’s Communities Celebrate Together

- ⇒ At noon, a “Salute to the Union” is fired, each July 4th, by any capable military base. This is a salute of one gun for each state in the United States.
- ⇒ In 2009, New York City hosted the largest fireworks display in the country.
- ⇒ Held since 1785, the Bristol Fourth of July Parade in Bristol, Rhode Island, is the oldest continuous Independence Day celebration in the United States.


Welcome our new employees







A few notes from the Accounting office

First, we wish to thank everyone who pays their rent on time every month!

- * Remember, cash is not accepted. Your payments must be made by check or money order. **Please make sure the check or money order is written for the correct amount.** A partial payment cannot be accepted! Your account will show as not paid until the full amount is received.
- * If your name and apartment/unit number are not pre-printed on the check or money order, please make sure that information is **legibly written** on the document. This will expedite crediting your payment to your account.
- * Likewise, if someone else is making your rent payments on your behalf, please ask them to make sure that **your name** and apartment/unit number are on the check or money order.
- * Late fees will be applied if your rent payment is not received by the due date. Typically, this is 3:00 p.m. on the 5th of the month. Please refer to your lease for the specifics.
- * If you are one of the many tenants that like to pay your rent ahead, we would appreciate it if you would wait to send in the next month's rent until after the 15th of the current month. Thank you.
- * It is also very helpful to have current contact information, such as a phone number or email address, on file. Please check with your housing specialist if you need to update that information.
- * Please be sure to place your rent in the RENT DROP BOX, which is checked two times a day.

Friendly Reminders

It brings us great joy to be able to serve our residents daily!
In order to provide the best service possible to you, here are few things to be mindful of:

- * Please take note of our normal office hours in each tower, of 9am-12pm and 12:30pm-3pm. If you happen to miss us during our normal business hours, we invite you to come see us the next business day during office hours.
- * Staff members return voicemails in the order they were received. When leaving us a voicemail, please allow us 24 to 48 hours to return your call.
- * Please contact Amazon directly if you have questions about packages, as FHA is not responsible for packages and do not track or manage deliveries.
- * If you need to place a work order, please place it with your Housing Specialist so that it can be documented and given to maintenance for timely repair.
- * Recertifications notices are mandatory and are issued 120 days prior to recertification of your rent.
- * The RSSC office has two new computers for you to use for your self-sufficiency needs. Please feel free to stop by should you need access to computer services.
