Classic Chicken with Alfredo Sauce Amounts according to size of dish you wish to use.

Cook several chicken breasts in chicken broth, cut up into small pieces when cooled. Cook noodles in chicken broth till done may need to add water to cover noodles.

1-2 can cream of chicken soup, 1 can of milk.

Onion, other seasonings to taste (garlic, parmesan cheese, salt & pepper, a little melted butter)
Mix all together including broth pour into pan, sprinkle stop with seasoned crumbs or cracker crumbs. Bake at 350* for 35 minutes.
