and have a congregate meal Monday through Friday. If
you are age 60 and older or on disability you may be able
to get your meals paid for by the State if you meet their
guidelines. If you do not qualify for free meals you can



\$61.30 for a ten day ticket, that is only \$6.13 per home cooked meal. You get to choose the days that you want to eat if your meals are free or if you purchase a ticket.

Appointments must be scheduled between 9:00 am-12:00 pm or 12:30 pm-3:00 pm.




Just a reminder that office hours are 9:00-12:00 and 12:30-3:00. Please do not knock on office doors after these hour.....this is our paperwork/catch up
